The face-to-face training course on "Smart Sustainable Cities driven by Data, Network, AI Technologies" is scheduled to be held in Jeju, Republic of Korea from 15-18 July 2019. This training is organized jointly by the International Telecommunication Union and National Information Society Agency (NIA), in partnership with the World Bank and the World Smart Sustainable Cities Organization (WeGO), as part of the ICT Application programme under the auspices of the ITU Centres of Excellence for Asia-Pacific. The training course is designed to develop an understanding of the policy-making process to build smart sustainable cities, the application of frontier technologies, introducing the best practices and learning from the Republic of Korea, and share the challenges as well as lessons learnt.
