By improving national cybersecurity, countries will be better able and willing to work with other countries to improve cybersecurity regional and globally. This course will explore how more effective norms development and Confidence-Building Measures (CBMs) implementation can be achieved by carefully assessing the pros and cons of various venues and formats as well as taking advantage of existing synergies between UN initiatives and regional CBM and capacity-building initiatives.
