The curriculum explores governance and covers policy development, ethical standards and regulatory frameworks in cybersecurity to ensure organizations' compliance with the latest threats, risk assessment methodologies, and security best practices. In addition, participants will also learn to create a risk management plan and learn about post-incident activities such as forensic investigations, recovery methods, incident response planning which by the end of the course, will prepare the participants to take part in a wide range of threat management and incident response activities as cybersecurity operators.
