The face-to-face ITU Asia-Pacific Centre of Excellence (ITU ASP CoE) Training on "Traffic engineering and advanced wireless network planning" will be conducted from 17-19 October 2018 at Suva, Fiji. This face-to-face training is organized jointly by the International Telecommunication Union, Pacific Islands Telecommunication Association and the Ministry of Digital Economy and Society (Thailand) as part of the Broadband Access programme under the auspices of the ITU Centres of Excellence for Asia-Pacific Region. The training is hosted by the Department of Communication (Government of Fiji) and is supported by the Department of Communications and the Arts (Government of Australia). The training will be delivered in English language. The training will be preceded by the PITA Telecoms Digital Strategy Forum, which will be held from 15-16 October 2018 at the same venue.
