Training description

This course provides an introduction to artificial intelligence (AI), with a focus on its application in the public service. Participants will be guided through the entire process of devising AI-based services in the public sector. Lessons will cover not just the functional aspects of this application but also the governance and ethical aspects of the process to offer a holistic point of view.

The course will be delivered at <u>Cetic.br</u>, a **Category 2 Center under the auspices of UNESCO** in São Paulo, Brazil. The content of this course is built on the <u>Al4Gov Master Programme</u>, formerly supported by the EU and offered by Universidad Politécnica de Madrid and Politecnico di Milano.

With the generous support of the Global Gateway initiative of the European Union, this course is offered for free for selected participants. This includes accommodation, meals, and other organized activities. Participants or their organizations will be responsible for covering their travel expenses to São Paulo, Brazil and if necessary, visa application costs.
