## Description

This 5-day training course equips policymakers, regulators, civil society leaders, and professionals with the essential knowledge and practical tools to navigate the field of AI governance.

The training will begin with online preparatory work, providing an introduction to key AI concepts, emerging risks, legal frameworks, and ethical governance models. It includes interactive quizzes, case studies, and live Q&A sessions

The in-person component of the training is built around real-world simulations, design thinking labs,

---

and collaborative scenario analysis. Participants will explore the full lifecycle of AI systems-mapping risks, identifying oversight gaps, and co-designing regulatory interventions. By the end of the course, participants will have developed a five-year AI governance action plan to be implemented by their countries or institutions. The plan will be tailored to their local context in line with international best practices and rights-based safeguards.

With generous support from the Global Gateway initiative of the European Union, participation in this inaugural delivery of the programme is offered free of charge for selected applicants. This includes accommodation, meals, and other planned learning activities during the training. Participants or their organizations are responsible for covering their travel expenses and visa application costs for Geneva, Switzerland, if applicable.
