### Training description

Organized by ITU and the World Bank, with support from the United Kingdom Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office, the training on satellite regulations is designed to allow participants to gain greater knowledge and a more in-depth understanding of the **key principles of satellite regulations** with a focus on LEO satellite communications (Broadband and IoT). The course will examine the international legal and regulatory framework that governs the use and management of **radio frequency spectrum and associated orbits, ITU's specific regulatory processes,**

national and regional licensing and spectrum allocation frameworks, the roles and responsibilities of the different agencies, the importance of monitoring and enforcement, market access and service offerings. Participants will gain insights into technological and economic aspects, security, risk mitigation and resiliency requirements, and be familiarized with the World Bank's procurement approaches on broadband connectivity with a specific focus on the role of satellite within the broader technology mix to achieve universal meaningful connectivity.

**Practical scenarios and case studies** will be utilized to illustrate the application of these regulations in real-world situations.
