Tailored for senior professionals working in ICT, telecommunications, and regulatory roles, the program responds directly to a core need identified by members: the ability to elevate public speaking, navigate networks, influence across cultures, and strengthen negotiation strategies.

Building on the momentum of the NoW masterclasses held back-to-back with the Global Symposium for Regulators 2025 (GSR-25) in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, this training series is highly dynamic, interactive, and immersive. Each session combines proven methodologies with practical, actionable tools that participants can immediately apply in a variety of contexts. From commanding presence and reducing fear and stress, to increasing clarity, persuasion, and influence, the course equips participants with a holistic communication toolkit:

- Frameworks to deliver messages with precision and impact.
- Techniques to strengthen body language and voice for greater presence.
- Tools to manage emotions, overcome anxiety, and project confidence.
- Models to build rapport, influence stakeholders, and negotiate outcomes effectively.
- Self-reflection work that strengthens sense of identity, courage, and resilience.

By the end of the series, participants will have significantly enhanced their ability to embody presence, competence, and confidence, empowering them to advocate powerfully for their organizations and their countries on the global stage.
