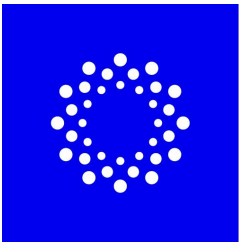

Learners will also gain insights into workflow data structures, interoperability through service APIs, and performance standards required for scalable and secure implementation in distributed environments.

By mastering the core principles of the Workflow Building Block, participants are empowered to drive efficient-first digital transformation and build transparent, responsive, and citizen-focused service delivery systems. This course supports the realization of sustainable, accessible, and interoperable digital ecosystems, contributing to the achievement of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly those related to digital innovation, service efficiency, and responsible governance.
