Training description

This course focuses on enhancing the protection and cyber resilience of Critical Information Infrastructures (CII). These include essential assets, systems, and functions whose disruption or destruction could severely impact a nation's economy, government operations, public health and safety, as well as national defense and security.

The course introduces participants to key concepts, policies, guidelines, and preparedness measures essential for safeguarding CII. It also examines practical implementation aspects and the legal framework underpinning national CII protection policies.
