This online self-paced course is part of the broader master course [AI governance: fundamentals](#), which introduces learners to key concepts, challenges, and frameworks shaping the governance of Artificial Intelligence (AI).

While this course can be taken as a standalone module, it also forms one of five building blocks of the full learning journey. Participants may choose to focus on this specific topic or complete the master course to gain a comprehensive understanding of AI governance. Designed for non-technical audiences, the course equips policymakers, professionals, and civil society actors with the knowledge needed to critically assess AI systems and engage in governance discussions.

Upon successful completion of this course, participants will receive an ITU Academy badge. Learners who complete all five courses and pass the final assessment in the master course will earn an additional ITU Academy badge.
