Abidjan is generally safe. Nevertheless, participants are recommended to be very cautious in order to avoid any inconvenience. 13. HEALTH

For any health reasons, you can contact the University Hospital of Treichville at 21 24 91 22/21 24 91 55/21 25 65 70, the University Hospital ofCocody at 22 48 10 00 / 22 44 91 00, the Clinic closest to the hotel, or the Polyclinic PISAM at 22 48 31 31.

Please take with you the immunization records. They are requested by the hygiene services at the airport before entering the Ivoirian territory. Also make sure your yellow fever vaccine is valid.

Tap water is safe, however, it is recommended to use bottles of mineral water.

14. WEATHER

The weather in Abidjan in November is hot with 92 millimeters of rain over 23 days. Temperatures can rise to up 32 ° Celsius. The minimum seasonal temperature is 29 ° Celsius; causing the temperature in October in Abidjan to be around 31 ° Celsius.

15. INTERNET

The hotels have internet connections available for the customers. On the venue of the meeting, participants will have broadband Internet access.
