- Government officials, employees of public institutions or senior-level researchers at national research institutes working in the ICT fields, with a Bachelor's or Master's degree
- Applicants with proven English proficiency such as the minimum TOEIC 720, TOEFL(IBT 83, PBT 560, CBT 220), IELTS 6.5, TEPS 599 or higher.

\* English Proficiency test should have been taken within 2 years from the deadline of the online application.

- \*\* English Proficiency test can be replaced by English phone interview with ITTP director.
- Financial Support(Master's Degree: up to 2 years/ Doctorate: up to 3 years)
- Tuition fee
- One-way airfare(Economy class, Max KRW 1,500,000)
- Living cost (KRW 1,500,000 per month)
- National medical insurance
- Relocation expenses
