8. DETAILS OF ARRIVAL AND TRANSPORT

By Plane

Vilnius is easily accessible by air from all major European cities. It takes less than three hours to fly in from many European cities and "hubs" including Barcelona, Paris, Copenhagen, London and Frankfurt.

From the airport to the city

Vilnius International Airport is located just outside the centre of Vilnius. It is only 7 km/15 min drive from the city centre. Access to the city is quick and inexpensive. Guests can use buses (<http://www.vilniustransport.lt/en/>), train (www.litrail.lt) and taxi services.

Buses are located outside the Arrival Hall. Tickets can be bought from the driver for 1 Eur. A special train runs from Vilnius Airport to the main train station. The journey takes just seven minutes. Tickets are sold on board for just 0,70 Eur.

Taxis can be found outside the Arrival Hall, or they can be ordered in Vilnius Tourist Information Centre at the Arrival Hall A. Also, taxi can be ordered via Uber or Taxify. The price for a taxi ride from the airport to the city centre is approx. 10 Eur.
