3. REGISTRATION

4. VISA FORMALITIES

- i. Most nationalities do not require visas for social or business visits to Malaysia. Visitors to Malaysia must be in possession of a valid passport or travel document with a minimum validity of six months beyond the period of stay.
- ii. Nationals from countries which require a visa can apply through the nearest Malaysian overseas mission (or log onto www.imi.gov.my) by submitting the following documentation:
 - Visa application form with three (3) passport-sized photographs
 - National passport with remaining validity not less than six (6) months
 - Letter of introduction or invitation letter

6. DETAILS OF ARRIVAL AND TRANSPORT

Kuala Lumpur is served by two main airports; Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) and Kuala Lumpur International Airport 2 (KLIA 2). Participants can travel from the airports to UTM Kuala Lumpur through various modes of ground transportation.

i. By KLIA Ekspres: www.kliaekspres.com

The KLIA Ekspres is a non-stop, Airport rail link service between the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) and the Kuala Lumpur Sentral (KL Sentral). The journey takes 28 minutes with a fee of MYR55/one way. Travelers can purchase the tickets either by automated ticketing machines or by ticketing staff at the stations.

From KL Sentral Station, you will have to catch a metered taxi to get to UTM KL and the nearby hotels.

ii. By Taxi

For convenience, especially for those with big luggage, it is advisable that attendees take the airport taxis direct to the KLCC and nearby hotels. Airport taxis both budget and premier are available at the Kuala Lumpur International Airport on a 24-hour basis. Coupons can be purchased at the taxi coupon counters located at International Arrival Hall and Domestic Arrival Hall.

Estimate Taxi Fare* (from KLIA/KLIA2 to KLCC):

Budget Taxi = MYR 74.30

Premier Taxi = MYR 102.10

*The rates are subject to change without prior notice. Kindly obtain the exact rate at the taxi coupon counter upon arrival.

Journey Time: approx. 50-60 mins.

iii. By Bus

Shuttle bus service is available from KLIA and KLIA 2 to KL Sentral. From KL Sentral Station, you will have to catch a metered taxi to get to UTM KL.

iv. Ride Hailing App – Grab

Ride Hailing App- Grab can be used to book a Grab car or Taxi to fetch you from the airport to UTM Kuala Lumpur.

7. CURRENCY

The currency in Malaysia is Malaysian Ringgit, indicated as 'MYR'. Visit http://www.bnm.gov.my/index.php?ch=statistic&pg=stats exchangerates for the latest exchange rates. Foreign Exchange Booths are common and clearly state the exchange rate for all major currencies. Automated Teller Machines (ATMs) are located at major bank branches, most shopping malls, airports, bus terminals, etc. Note that ATMs in Malaysia require a six-digit PIN. Please be advised that if your ATM PIN is more or less than six digits, it should be changed before departing.

8. ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

Voltage is 230 - 240 volts AC at 50Hz cycles per second. The power plugs and sockets are of type G.



9. LANGUAGES

The course will be delivered in English.

Bahasa Malaysia or Malay is the official language while English is widely spoken. Most Malaysians can speak at least two languages, Malay and English, while some are tri-lingual, being able to converse in Mandarin and Tamil too.

10. MEDICAL AND HEALTH

The university health centre is available in the campus for outpatient and emergency.

At UTM, free WIFI Internet is available in the campus. High Speed Broadband is easily accessible at hotels, internet cafés and shopping malls, among other places.
