ITU Capacity development and the role of the ATC programme

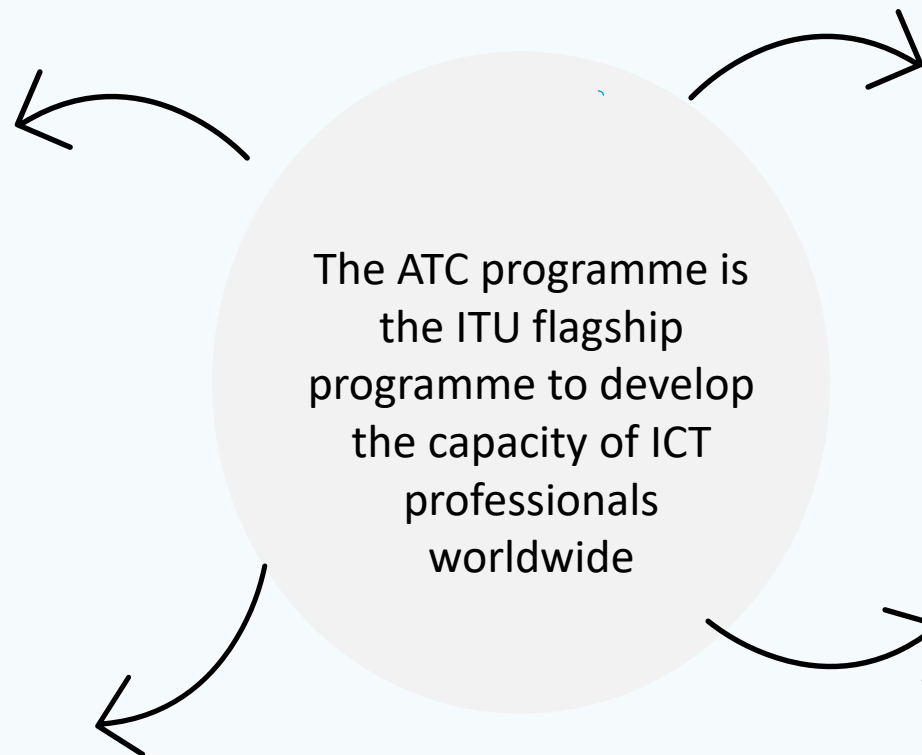
ITU/BDT core mandate:

Strengthen the capacity of policy makers in the field of ICT, in particular in developing countries

- WTDC-22 Kigali Action Plan
- PP-22 Final Acts

Cutting across all ITU areas of work

Identified by the ITU membership as priorities



ITU Academy:

recognized as the main umbrella to harmonize all ITU capacity development and training activities

ATCs: core delivery partners

of ITU on capacity development

- Resolution 73, WTDC-22
- Strong integration with ITU/BDT operational work

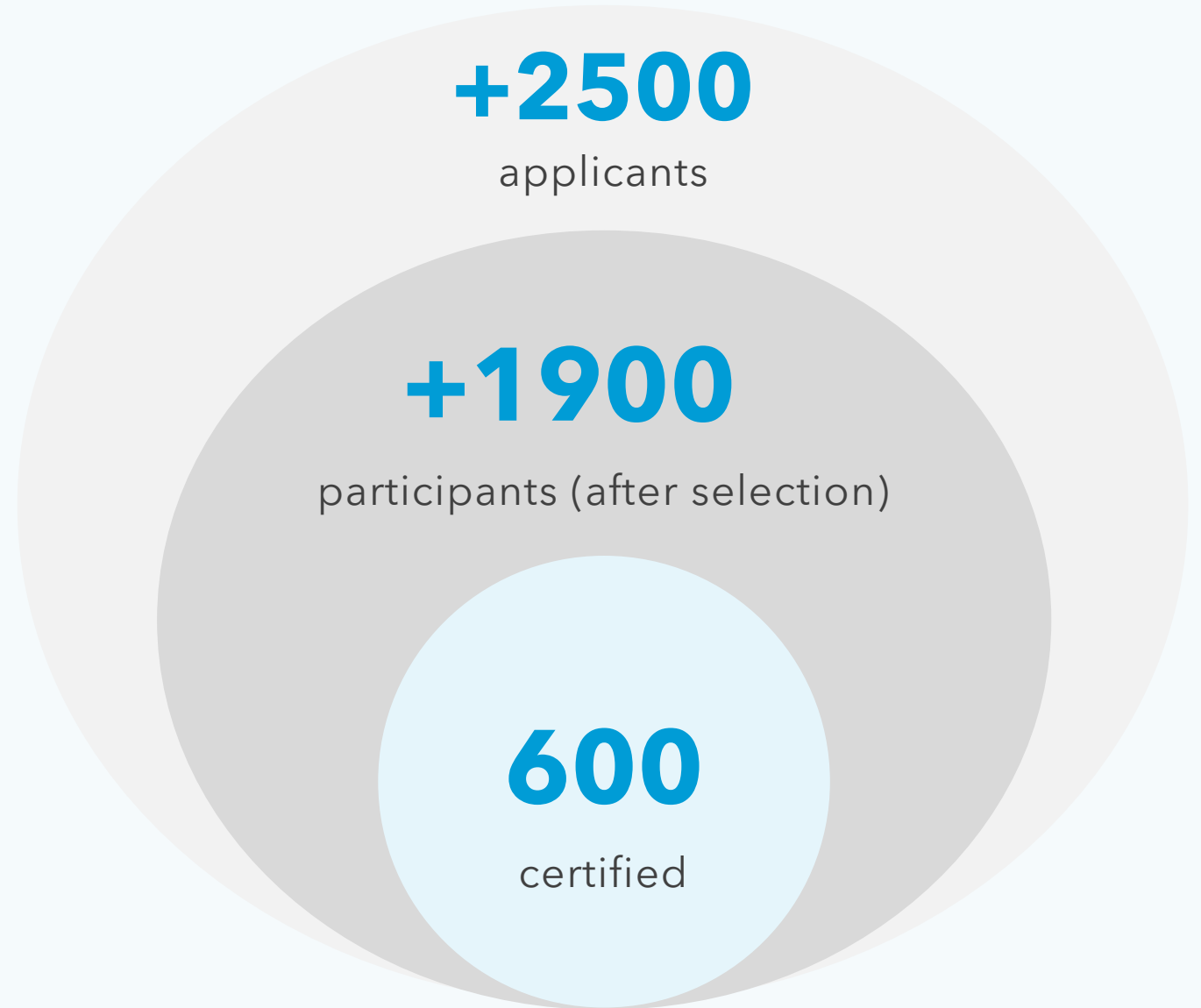
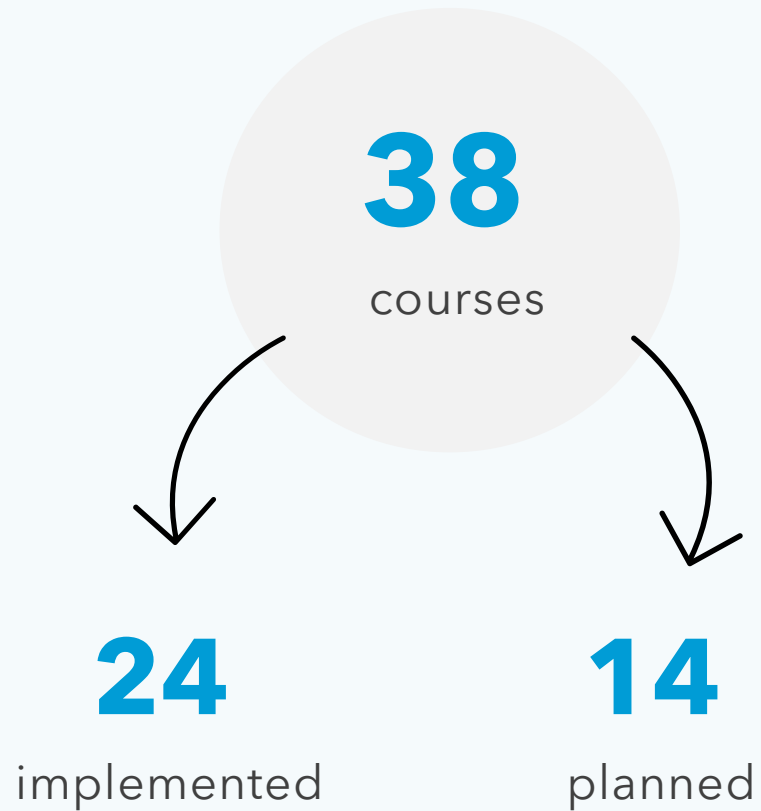

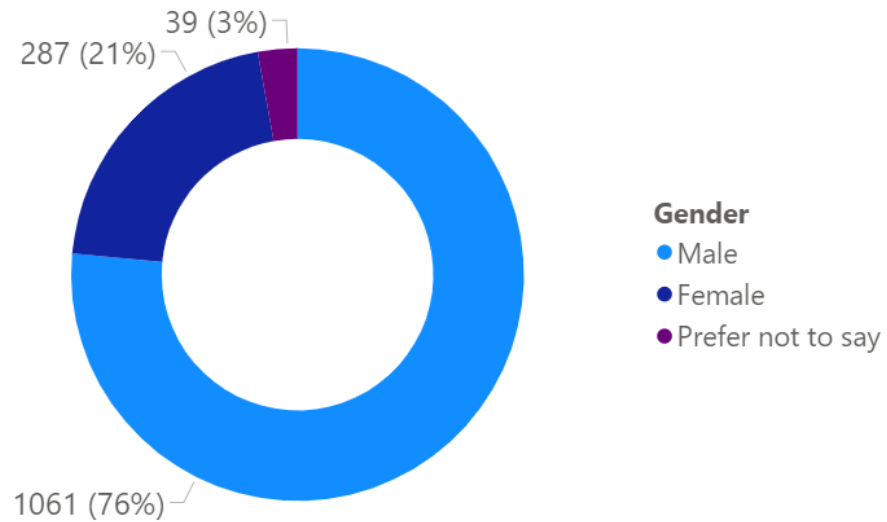

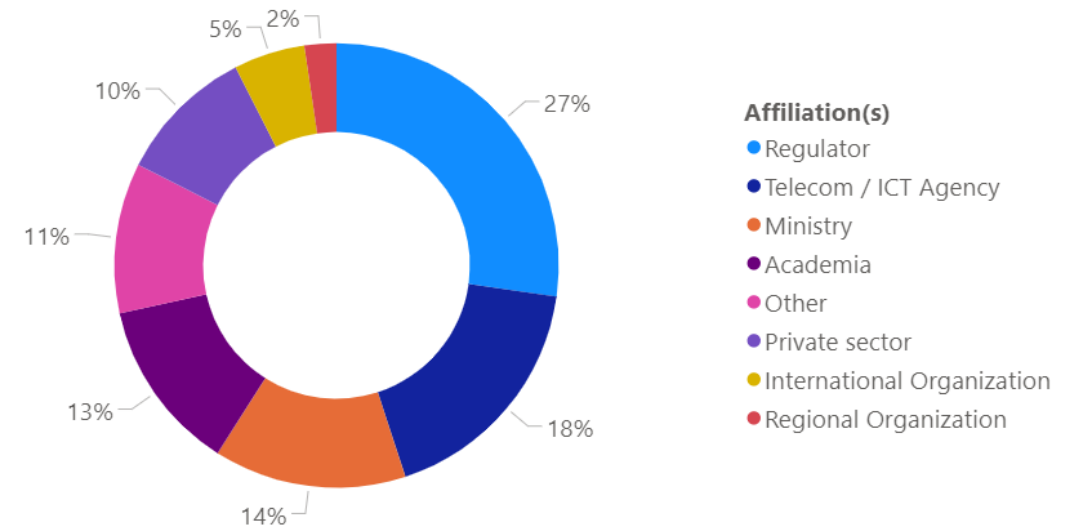
First year in numbers

Number of participants by gender



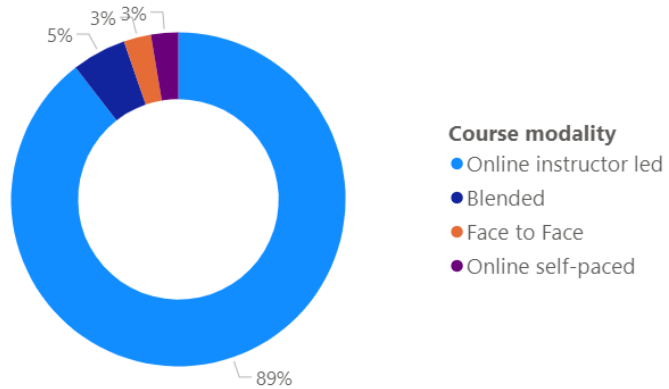
Number of participants by organizational affiliation(s)

(Multiple affiliations allowed)

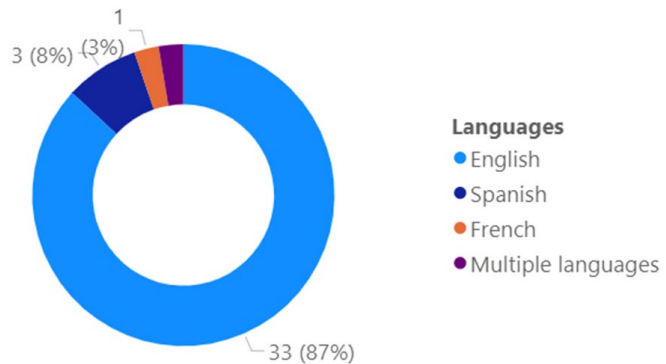

Number of planned or implemented courses by modality

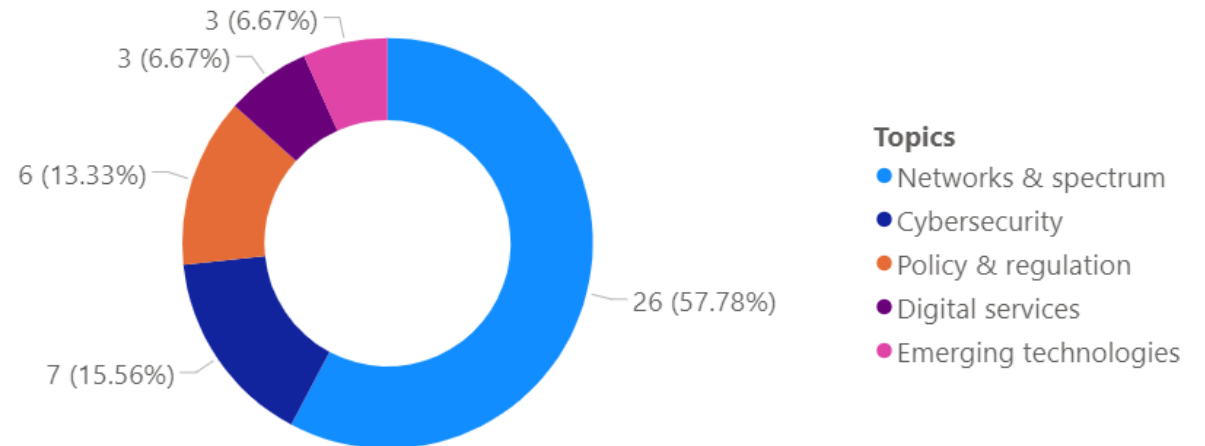


Number of planned or implemented courses by language of delivery



Number of courses per topic(s)

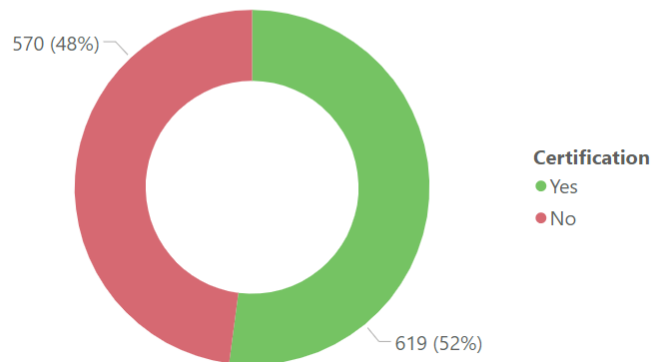

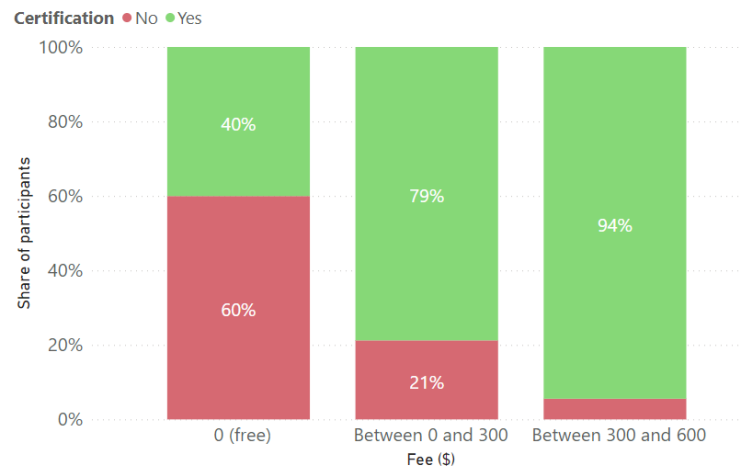
Share of participants who have earned a certificate of completion

(Only applied to courses that have finished to date)



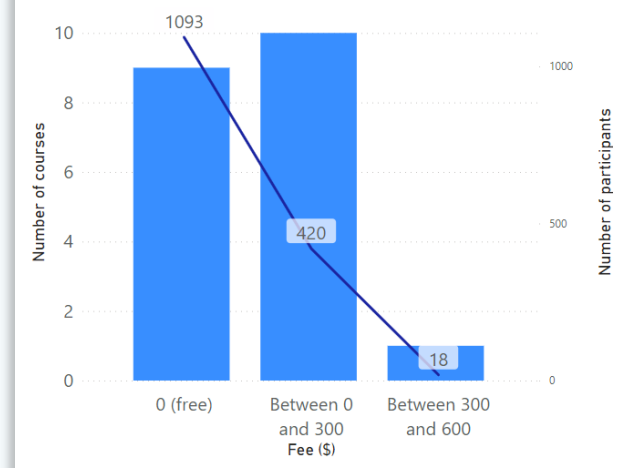
Share of participants who earned a certificate of completion by level of course fee

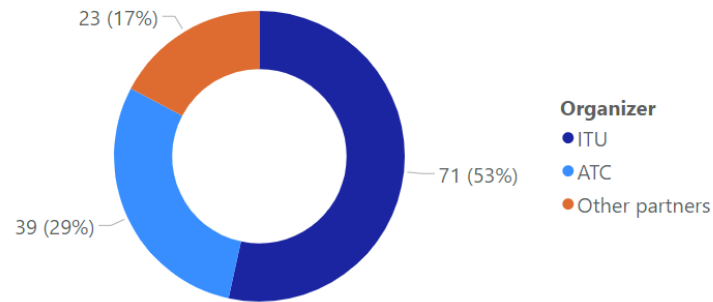
Country origin of participants

(Bubble size represents the number of participants from each country)

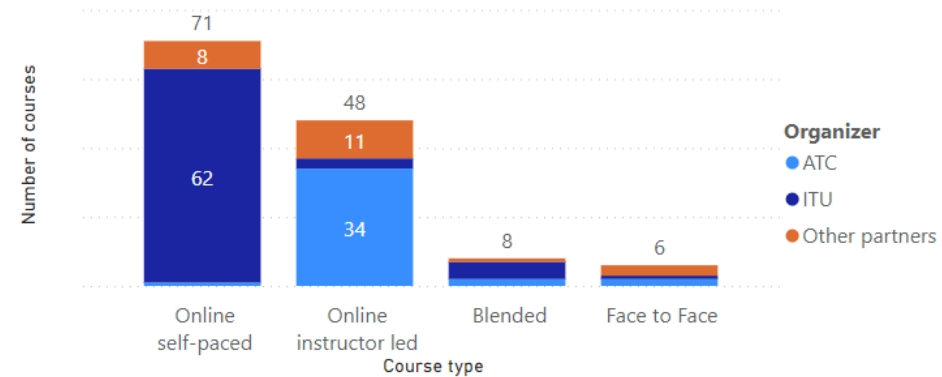

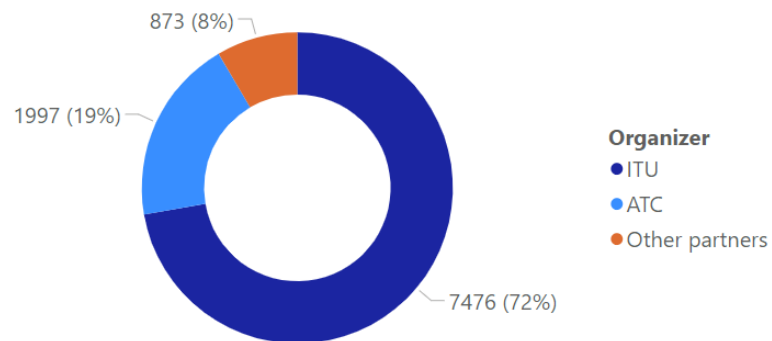
Number of planned or implemented courses on the ITU Academy in 2023



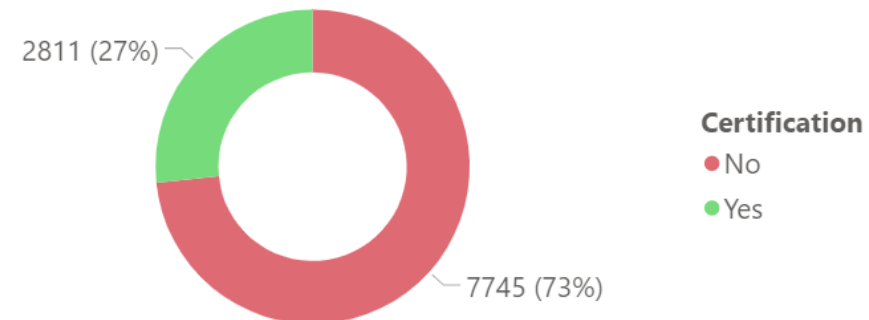
Number of planned or implemented courses on the ITU Academy in 2023, by modality
