COURSE DESCRIPTION

Title	Information Security Management System (ISMS)
Objectives	With the completion of this training, learners will have a deep understanding of the benefits of ISMS, and the knowledge on how to plan and implement ISMS all by themselves. They will be able to integrate the ISMS in the management structure of a company or organization in connection with other management systems. Finally, they will be able to prepare their company or organization to meet the requirements to successfully complete a certification audit according to ISO 27001.

- 2. What are basic principles of information security management?
- 3. Where is the risk management happened?
- 4. How to establish a security management system?
- 5. What gives and how is performed the certification according to ISO 27001?

TARGET POPULATION

This training is designed to meet the needs of anyone who wishes to ensure a high level of information security, be it because he wants to offer digital goods or services, to protect his own assets, to offer his customers the best possible protection, or because he is obliged by regulations to comply with information security. The training offers an introduction as well as a thorough overview for anyone involved with information security, i. e. members of the top-level management of companies and organizations as well as prospective security officers and anyone responsible for security issues from the perspective of regulators, IT, and business processes.

EVALUATION

By choice, learners can complete an exam in the end in order to receive an ITU Centrer of Excellence Certificate on Information Security Management Systems.

METHODOLOGY

The course is self-paced online course with lecturing materials accompanied with different media. Each page of the course includes link to external sources of information, which could be used to get deeper knowledge of some particular topics.

Each of the modules takes up to 45 minutes to complete and enhanced with self-assessment mini-quiz.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

ITU Academy portal account

Payment

1. On-line payment

A training fee of USD 250 per participant is applied for this training. Payment should be made via the online system using the link mentioned above for training registration at https://academy.itu.int/training-courses/full-catalogue/information-security-management-system.

2. Payment by bank transfer

Where it is not possible to make payment via the online system, select the option for offline payment to generate an invoice using the same link as above. Download the invoice to make a bank transfer to the ITU bank account shown below. Then send the proof of payment/copy of bank transfer slip and the invoice copy to <u>Hcbmail@itu.int</u> and copy the course coordinator. **All bank transaction fees must be <u>borne by the</u> <u>payer</u>.**

Failure to submit the above documents may result in the applicant not being registered for the training.

3. Group payment

Should you wish to pay for more than one participant using bank transfer and need one invoice for all of them, create an account as **Institutional Contact. Institutional Contacts** are users that represent an organization. Any student can request to be an institutional contact or to belong to any existing organization.

To do this, head to your profile page by clicking on the "**My account**" button in the user menu. At the bottom of this page you should see two buttons:

- a. If you want to **become an institutional contact**, click on the "**Apply to be an Institutional Contact**" button. This will redirect you to a small form that will ask for the organization name. After you fill the name of the organization you want to represent, click on "**continue**" and a request will be created. An ITU Academy manager will manually review this request and accept or deny it accordingly.
- b. If you want to belong to an existing organization, click on the "Request to belong to an Institutional Contact" button. This will redirect you to a small form that will ask you to select the organization you want to join from an organization list. After you select the correct organization, click on "continue", a request will then be created. The Institutional Contact that represents that organization will manually accept or deny your request to join the organization.
