## Highlights from 2024



- **+ 168,000 (52% female)** participants trained by DTCs in basic and intermediate digital skills in 2024. An increase of 30% compared to 2023.

- ITU Digital Skills Forum in Bahrain, with participation of DTCs and DTCTI partners



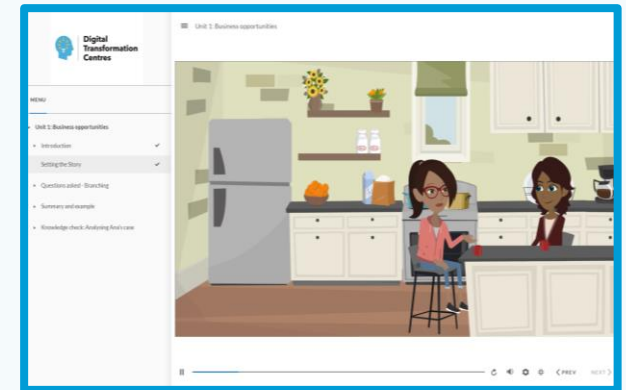
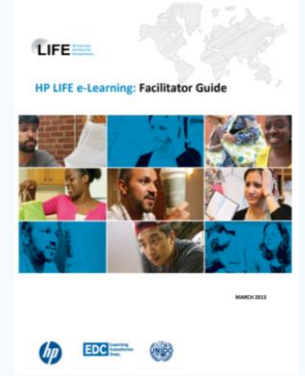
## Highlights from 2024

- **Closure of the first phase of the first project funded by ITU and Norway:** “Boosting digital skills through Digital Transformation Centres” Project. Release of the DTC Ghana - Project documentary.
- Continued partnership between ITU and Norway: Start of **Phase II of the DTC Project**, with on-going support to DTCs to conduct citizens training, train-the-trainer and/or schoolteachers, and outreach activities
- **A 5-year review report** showcasing the impact and highlights of the DTC Initiative was developed by ITU (**to be published soon**).



## Highlights on DTCL training content

- New digital literacy courses added to the **Cisco portfolio**
- Roll-out of the **ST Foundation** course on ICBVI to two new DTC countries (Pakistan, Uganda)

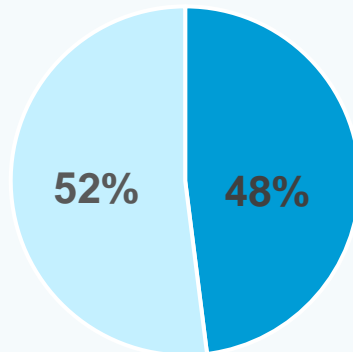

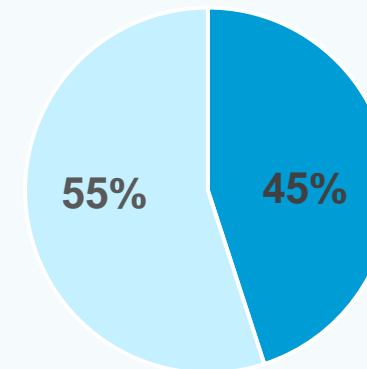
## DTC activities (2020 – April 2025)

## Project-funded activities (June 2024 – May 2025)

Between June 2024 and May 2025, ITU and DTCT partners provided financial support to:

- **7 DTCTs** to conduct citizens training activities
- **8 DTCTs** to roll-out train-the-trainer programmes
- **3 DTCTs** to organise outreach, engagement and promotional activities.
- Support is on-going with several other activities under planning.

## Project-funded activities (June 2024 – May 2025)



**DRC:** Train-the-trainer on basic and intermediate digital skills as part of the CONADIG Digital Ambassadors programme



**Ivory Coast:** Citizens training for middle-school students were delivered under the “Digital Holidays” programme, trained by the Young Digital Ambassadors.



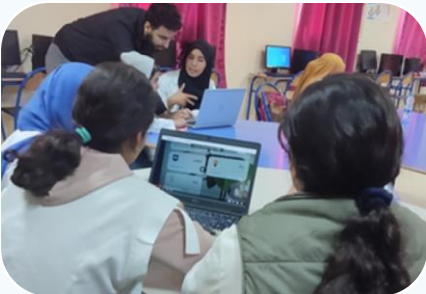
**Zambia:** Citizens training for cooperative members in the localities of Mumbwa, Chipata, Cibombo, Kafue, Choma, and Mongu.



**Senegal:** Train-the-trainer, citizens training and outreach activities on the ICBVI programme for visually impaired individuals



**Pakistan:** First train-the-trainer programme to launch the “Introduction to Computer Basics for the Visually Impaired” course



**Morocco:** Digital literacy training programme for 400 young female students from rural communities



**Dominican Republic:** Digital skills training programmes to empower female and male inmates



**Sierra Leone:** Train-the-trainer programme to equip 159+ trainers across the country with the skills to deliver Cisco and HP-LIFE courses



**Uganda:** Launch of the ICBVI programme through the first train—the-trainer course for 20 visually impaired and sighted instructors



**Ghana:** Train-the-trainer programme for ICT female trainers and schoolteachers

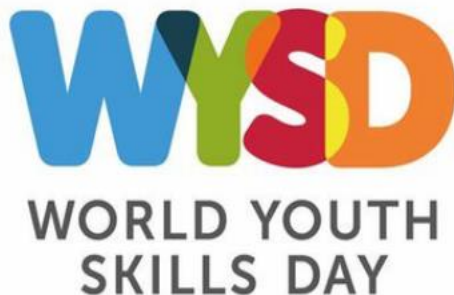
