ITU will offer accommodation in a hotel close to the training venue. The name and location of the hotel will be confirmed soon.

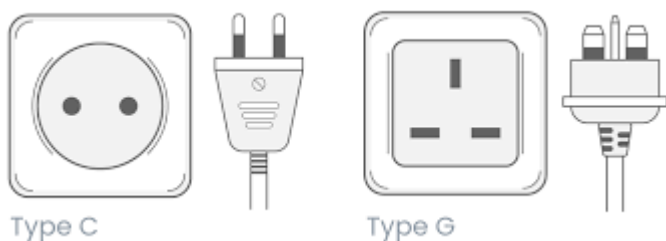
5. CURRENCY
