The delegates from international locations should fly to O.R. Tambo International Airport (Code: JHB). The recommended mode of travel from the Airport is the hotel shuttle, which should be pre-booked at the hotel.

Alternative travel will be either a metered taxi or those electronically booked such as Uber or Bolt. 3.
