(1) Government innovation based on emerging technologies

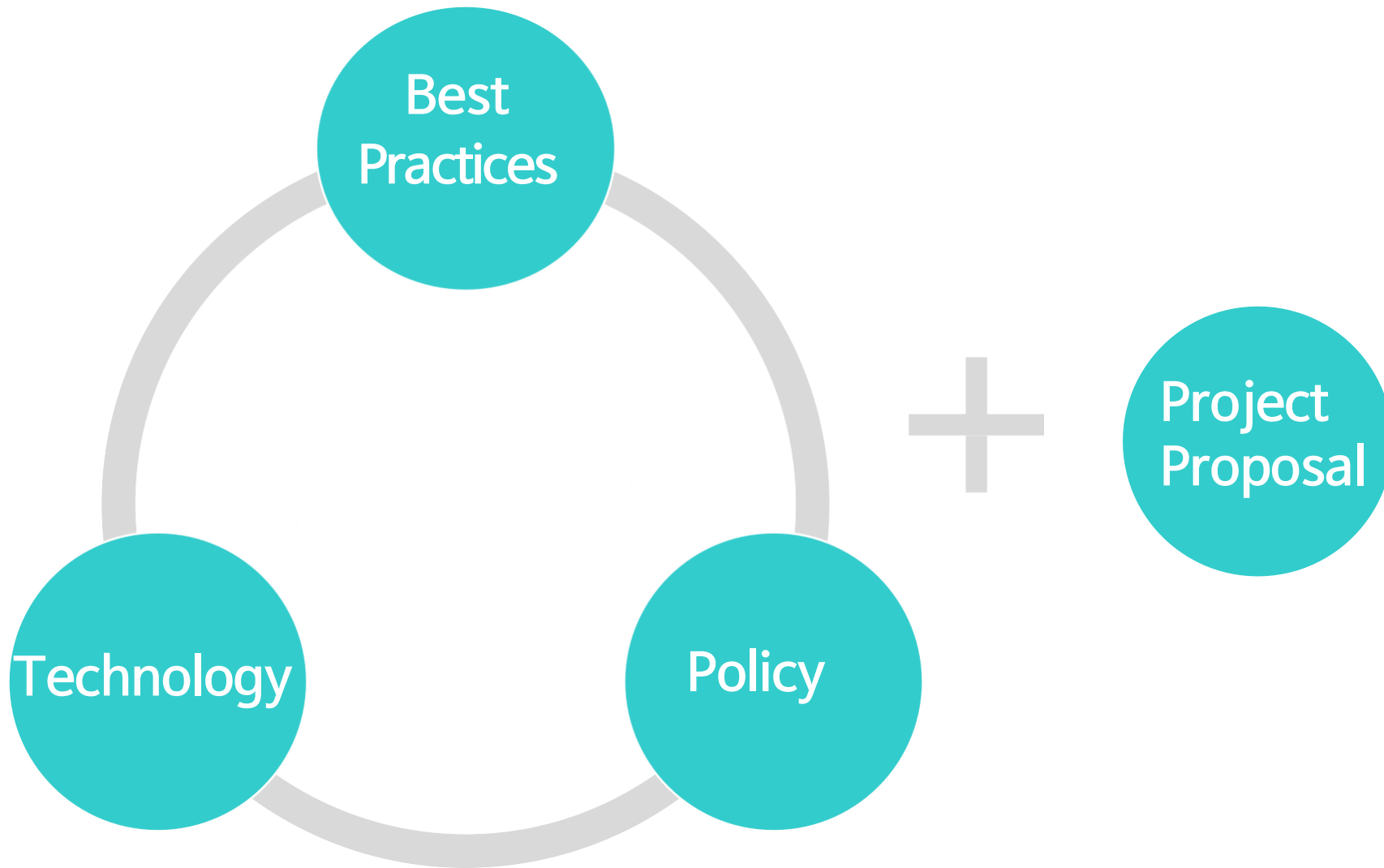
- Objective : To improve the quality of public service through government innovation using emerging technologies

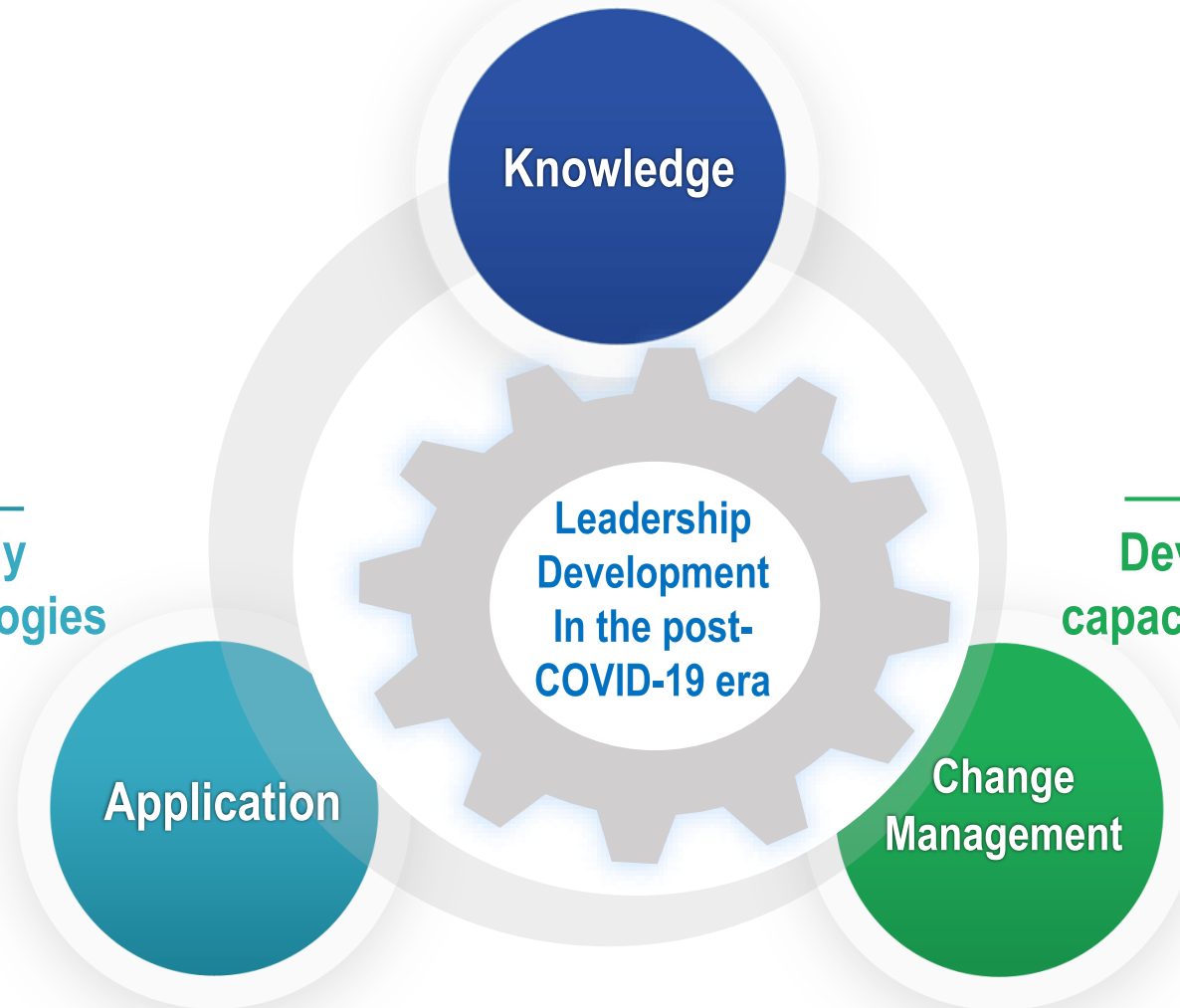
