Information note



The Global DTC Workshop and the annual meeting of the ITU Academy Training Centres (ATCs) will take place from **10 to 12 June 2025** in Santo Domingo, the Dominican Republic. The two events are organised by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and hosted by the Centros Tecnológicos Comunitarios (CTC), the DTC in the Dominican Republic, in collaboration with the Instituto Dominicano de las Telecomunicaciones (INDOTEL).

The Global DTC Workshop will bring together the DTC Initiative community and will provide a platform for ITU, Cisco, the DTCs and DTCI partners to discuss the implementation and governance of the Initiative as well as the operations of the centres. The annual meeting of the ITU ATCs will be joined by representatives of the current ATCs and will provide space for valuable exchanges in a practical, working setting, focusing the discussions on the implementation of the programme, strengthening of collaboration among centres and exploring innovative ideas.


Date and venue

Entry requirements

Passport holders from the following <u>list of countries</u> can travel to the Dominican Republic without a visa.

Visa application for countries with a diplomatic representation of the Dominican Republic:

Workshop participants which require a visa must apply for it at the diplomatic representation of the Dominican Republic in their country (consult the link above for the contact details). The following are the basic requirements for the application of temporary visitor's visa to the Dominican Republic:

- Visa Form, available at this link
- Front-facing photograph with white background
- Passport valid for at least 6 months
- Certificate of no criminal record
- Employment certification
- Guarantee letter from the sponsoring company in the Dominican Republic
- Documents demonstrating financial solvency
- Round-trip flight reservation
- Visa Fees

Countries with no representation of the Dominican Republic:


To avoid traveling to a third country in order to apply for a visa, a salvoconducto (exception) has been shared with concerned delegates. This letter, issued by the Ministry of External Relations of the Dominican Republic, is a personalised document confirming that a visa waiver to enter the country has been granted to the participant.

These letters have been issued in Spanish (as the official working language of the Ministry). It is strongly recommended for delegates to have their salvoconducto documents officially translated as this may be required for transit visa applications and/or requested by airlines or passport control staff at the departure or transit airport.

Currency

- The Dominican Peso (DOP) is the official currency of the Dominican Republic. 1 USD = 58.93 DOP (as of 1 May 2025).
- At Las Américas International Airport (AILA) in Santo Domingo, there are multiple banking and currency exchange options in both the arrivals and departures areas. Well-known exchange houses include Cambio Telemar and Casa de Cambio La Nacional, typically open during flight hours.
- Banks such as Banco Popular, Banco BHD León, and Scotiabank also have branches at the airport offering services like cash withdrawals, currency exchange, and other financial transactions-all designed for fast and secure service.

Language

The Global DTC Workshop and the annual meeting of the ITU Academy Training Centres (ATCs) will be held in English only.

Telecommunications and electrical appliances


Telecommunications

- The country code of the Dominican Republic is +1809
- Check if your mobile provider offers coverage in the Dominican Republic, or consider purchasing a local SIM card. Most hotels and restaurants provide Wi-Fi access.

Electricity Supply

- The electric supply in the Dominican Republic is 110 Volts, 60 Hertz.
- There are two major associated plug types in the Dominican Republic. Please refer to the images below.

Medical and health

The hotel provides medical service at a special rate.

Emergencies

- In case of an emergency, dial 911 to reach the police, medical, or fire services.
- It is also advised to have contact information for your hotel, embassy, or consulate. For tourist-specific assistance, you can reach out to the Specialized Tourist Security Corps (CESTUR).

Weather

- Time zone: The Dominican Republic follows the Atlantic Standard Time, which is four hours behind universal time (UTC 4).
- Santo Domingo has a warm, humid tropical climate year-round. Currently, thunderstorms and temperatures up to 32°C (90°F) are being reported. It is recommended to wear light and comfortable clothing, and to bring sunscreen, an umbrella, or a raincoat for sudden showers.
