1. TRAINING COURSE VENUE

The training will take place at **Tallinn University of Technology campus, Innovation Centre Mektory**. 2. DETAILS OF ARRIVAL AND LOCAL TRANSPORT

Participants arriving by air will land at **Tallinn Airport (Lennart Meri Tallinn Airport).** There will be no arranged airport transfers, so participants will need to use local transportation options.

Local transportation includes:

- **Public Transport:** Buses and trams are available from the airport to various parts of the city. The tram line number 4 connects the airport with the city center.
- **Taxis**: Estonian company **Bolt** is very widely used in Estonia, it is highly suggested to download as an app before arrival/during stay. Taxis are readily available outside the airport terminal. Reputable taxi services include Tulika Takso, Tallink Takso, and Tallinna Takso.

3. ONSITE REGISTRATION

Onsite registration will take place on the 4th of November at 10:00 AM. Participants can meet the coordinator at **Innovation Centre Mektory**, **Innovation Hub**.

3. VISA REQUIREMENTS

4. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation will be provided by ITU and TalTech at the Park Inn by Radisson Central Tallinn hotel.

Transportation between the airport and the accommodations:

- **Public Transport:** Trams and buses are available from Tallinn Airport to the city center. Tram line number 4 is a direct route to the city center.
- **Taxis:** Taxis are available at the airport. Taxi apps like Bolt, Forus Taxi, Uber also provide great taxi service. The ride to the city center takes about 10-15 minutes.
- **Airport Shuttle:** Some hotels may offer an airport shuttle service; please check with your chosen hotel.

From Park Inn by Radisson Central Tallinn to Tallinn University of Technology:

• Advisable to use **Google Maps** to get best routes and public transportation timetables between the hotel and our venue.

5. CURRENCY

The local currency is Euro (EUR). However, please note that major international currencies such as USD and GBP are generally not accepted directly but can be easily exchanged. Payments via credit card are widely accepted in most establishments, including hotels, restaurants, and shops. ATMs are readily available throughout the city for cash withdrawals.

6. ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

The country code of Estonia is +372.

The electric supply in Estonia is 230 volts, 50 hertz. There are two major associated plug types in Estonia: Type C and Type F, widely used around Europe.
